## Competence and Experience Requirements for SCS 9001 Certification Body Auditors

This document is a product of the Oversight Work Group of Telecommunications Industry Association QuEST Forum (TIA QF). It is subject to change by the Oversight Working Group with the latest version always appearing here. The purpose of this document is to define the competencies and experience for the specified Supply Chain Security auditor levels: 1) SCS 9001 Auditor and 2) SCS 9001 Lead Auditor.

### Section 1: General

### 1) Initial Requirements for SCS 9001 Auditor:

- a. Complete the SCS 9001 auditor training;
- b. Serve as auditor for an ISO 27001 full-system and 2 surveillance audits in the last 3 years, comprising of at least 20 audit days during that period;
- c. Meet the CB requirements for process-based auditing approach; and
- d. Complete CB requirements for SCS 9001 Team Member Auditor.
- 2. Initial Requirements for SCS 9001 Lead Auditor
  - a. Meet all requirements in Item 1 above;
  - b. Complete CB requirements for Lead Auditor for a Management System Standard; and
  - c. Complete CB requirements for SCS 9001 Lead Auditor

### Section 2: Maintenance Requirements for SCS Auditor:

- a) Participating in at least 3 SCS 9001 audits per each three-year period, and
- b) Completing a minimum of 2.0 CEUs in topics related to the cybersecurity or information security industries per each three-year period, including any additional courses required by TIA QuEST Forum.
- c) Maintenance Requirements for SCS 9001 Lead Auditors:
  - i. Participating in at least 6 SCS 9001 audits per each three-year period, with at leat one being a full system audit. They must also act as audit team leader in at least two of the 6 audits; and
  - ii. Completing a minimum of 3.0 CEUs in topics related to the cybersecurity or information security industries per each three-year period, including any additional courses required by TIA QuEST Forum.

#### Section 3: Failure to Maintain Qualifications

Any individual that fails to meet the maintenance qualifications for their classification shall be re-classified based on the qualifications that are met. They must fulfil the requirements not met to re-qualify and shall not audit at that auditor level until re-qualified.

Conformance to these qualification requirements shall be confirmed for each three-year period. The process shall be the responsibility of the Certification Bodies (CBs) and overseen by the Accreditation Bodies (ABs).

#### Section 4: Implementation Guidelines

All SCS 9001 auditors, as of the effective date of this document, shall meet the requirements.

IAF Mandatory Document (MD4) for the Use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) for Auditing/Assessment Purposes may be applied when maintaining SCS 9001 Auditors and SCS 9001 Lead Auditors.

Conducting a TIA SCS 9001 training session (note that you can only receive credit one time for each class, not for each time the class is delivered)	0.1 CEUs per Meeting Hour
Attendance at TIA /SCS 9001 training sessions conducted by your TIA representative	0.1 CEUs per Meeting Hour

Completion or Attendance Certificate documenting any CEU activity is, of course, required.
